## Director's Overview

Here's a step-by-step look at what you'll do as Director.

Step 1: First, check out the items in your Starter Kit.

- **Director Manual** gives you everything you need to know to make your Journey to the Cross a success!
- Leader Guides for your four Leaders make it easy to delegate responsibilities for outreach, setup, experiences, and the preschool experience.
- Journey to the Cross Publicity CD overflows with highquality art, forms, and publicity tools for attention-grabbing ways to invite your whole community.

Your kit also includes samples of these fun outreach tools and items:

- Collector Cards are collectible cards that guests will receive at each station. They offer instructions for families to follow at each station and reiterate the point: Jesus is alive today and he loves you. You'll need set of Collector Cards for each guest.
- Journey to the Cross Zipper Pulls give every guest a special reminder—and a great conversation starter!—with the message presented at Journey to the Cross—Jesus paid for our sins on the cross. He's alive today and he loves you!
- Journey to the Cross Family Time Together Book is a perfect gift to send home with families. The book offers simple pointers on how to turn everyday moments into meaningful family time, as well as 10 totally doable family devotions themed around the message of Easter.
