Tip the Tumble Drum and remember that when life is unfair and knocks you down, God is good and will put you back on your feet.

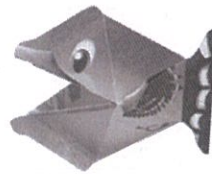
Discover how our perspective makes a difference in how we see God's goodness.

Honest gets to hunt at night with his father—which is a little fun but can also be scary. He remembers God's goodness, even when he's afraid.



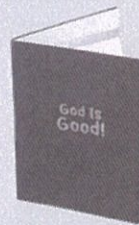
It can be a little scary waiting for the Hungry Hoopoe to fly. But kids can remember that when they're scared, God is always with them.
