# Christian Vision and Hearing Services (SPD)



Every individual is made in God's image and is a loved child of His. As a church, our mandate is to "...go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19-20.

We are to reach all people groups with God's Word before Jesus returns, including those who are on the margins with a disability.

Christian Vision and Hearing Services, within Adventist Media, is a non-profit organisation that serves people who are blind, have low vision, cannot read standard print due to a physical condition, are Deaf, hard of hearing or deafblind in the South Pacific Division. It provides vital services and support to these communities free of charge, made possible by this annual church offering, donations and bequests.

Christian Vision and Hearing Services undertakes important advocacy and awareness building within Adventist churches to make them more accessible and inclusive, provides audio and braille resources for the blind, distributes large print materials to those with low vision, funds captioning and Auslan interpretation for the Deaf, and provides subsidies for assistive listening systems in churches for the hard of hearing. It also offers development grants to qualifying individuals or organisations to pursue specialised training in the area of accessibility, so they can make a beneficial contribution in the lives of those with deafness, vision or hearing loss, or physical limitations within the Adventist church.

Please give generously to today's offering, to ensure the important work of Christian Vision and Hearing Services can continue and expand in 2026. # Adventist World Radio (GC)

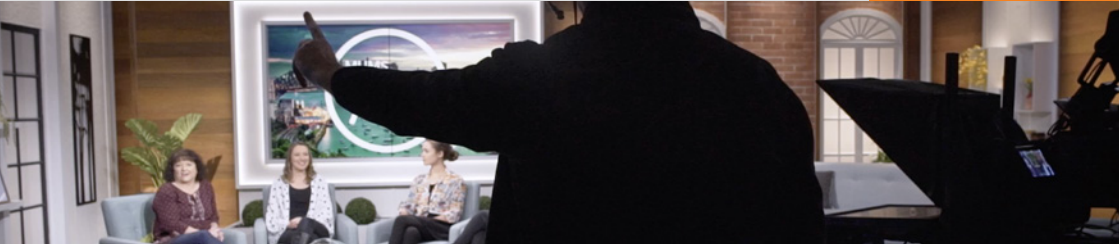

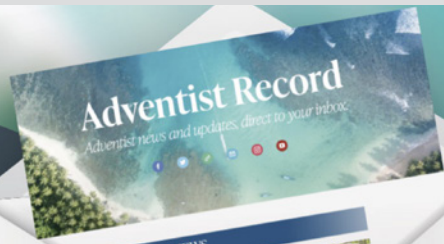

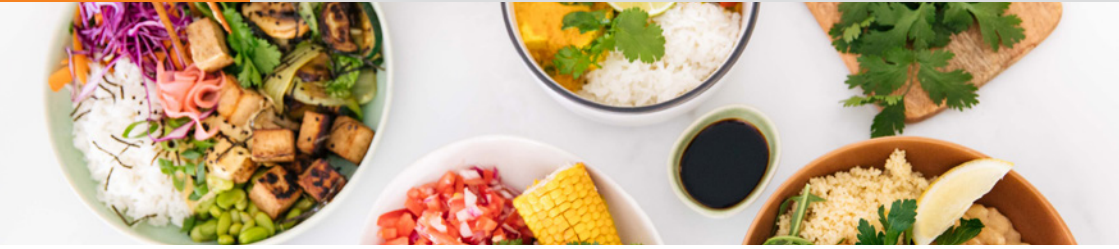

When an unexpected opportunity opens, allowing the Church to reach out to an otherwise unreachable region of the world, how does the Church provide the funds to make such a giant step for God?

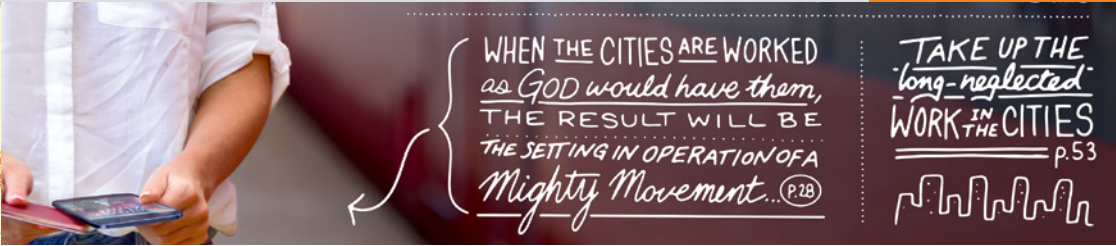

# Mission to the Cities (SPD)

It might surprise you to know that the most challenging mission field in the South Pacific Division is in our major cities, particularly amongst our post Christian, majority people groups. God loves our cities. The Great Controversy on earth starts in the Garden of Eden but ends in a City - the New Jerusalem. God said to Jonah, about the evil city of Nineveh, "should I not have pity on that great city?" When Ellen White wrote in 1910 that "the work in the cities is the essential work for this time", New York city was smaller than Sydney is today. The work in our cities is still our essential work.

We want to thank you for your faithfulness in giving to the Mission to the Cities offering last year. That offering is already being used in several projects including the Karla Bidjar First Nations Church Plant in Perth, Flatbush Church Plant in Auckland, New Design Community in Perth, Northern Beaches Church Plant in Sydney, Doncaster Hope Fellowship in Melbourne, the Brisbane Karen Church Plant and many more.

Please pray for our cities, pray for volunteers who will be willing to minister in our cities and pray that this Mission to the Cities offering will continue to help "the essential work of our time".

# Local Church Budget Offerings



Local Church Budget offerings are used for the day-to-day operation and ministries of the local church. These offerings cover essential running costs such as electricity, water, insurance and general maintenance of church buildings, equipment and grounds. These funds also support the various ministries of church life including Sabbath Schools, children's and youth ministries and worship services. In addition, these offerings enable the church to be active in the community through supporting outreach events and programs, Bible studies and food pantries.

All monies given to the Local Church Budget go towards creating a welcoming space for worship, nurturing spiritual growth and contributing to the church's mission.

# Sabbath School Offerings



## 12 Sabbaths

Sabbath School offerings go to mission programs and projects all around the world. These funds are administered by the General Conference, the global church headquarters.

## 13th Sabbath

25% of the funds received for the 13th Sabbath offering are allocated to the nominated 13th Sabbath special projects. For 2026, the 13th Sabbath School offerings will support projects in the following divisions:

- 1st Quarter 2026 - South Pacific Division (SPD)
- 2nd Quarter 2026 - East-Central Africa Division (ECD)
- 3rd Quarter 2026 - Inter-European Division (EUD)
- 4th Quarter 2026 - Trans-European Division (TED)

The balance of the funds goes directly to the world mission budget for other mission projects.

One of the challenges we face today is unity, and if we stand together and support the church under the Biblical storehouse model, we will remain strong. As soon as we fragment and every member gives tithe to whatever cause they may personally choose, our movement will lose momentum.

The graph below illustrates how the NSW Conference has been distributing tithe received from members in recent years. A significant portion is for Gospel workers, ministers and evangelism, which we believe is the highest and best use of our tithe based on the Bible and Spirit of Prophecy.



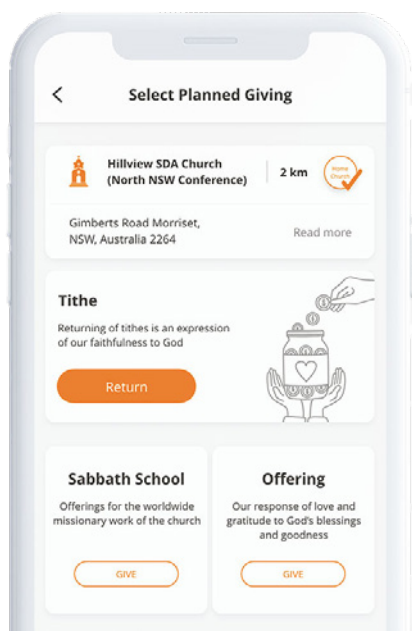
